FOSTERING FEES AND ALLOWANCES 2025

Families for Children highly values its approved foster carers and offers a package of training and support that values and recognises our carers' skills.

All Glasgow City Council foster carers receive a fee **plus** an allowance for each child/young person placed with them.

Current weekly fostering fees

Main Scheme fostering – per	£165
child/young person per week	

Fostering Allowances

Glasgow City Council (Families for Children) pays weekly allowances that are accepted as being a reasonable reflection of the cost of caring for a child.

In addition to the weekly allowances set out below, four additional payments are paid per year: two weeks holiday in the summertime, one week Christmas/Winter Festival period, and one week at the child or young person's birthday.

The child's allowance payment levels are:

Age Range	Weekly Allowance
0 – 4 years	£168.31
5 – 10 years	£195.81
11 – 15 years	£195.81
16 – 18 years	£195.81

As Scotland's largest provider of foster care, Families for Children is a busy service and our carers generally do not experience lengthy waiting times between placements unless they wish to do so. As the corporate parent for all of Glasgow's children, we will always place children with our own foster carers wherever possible, rather than purchase placements from independent providers. This means that as, a Families for Children foster carer, you will have the chance to do the role you train for – supporting Glasgow's children on an ongoing basis as part of a busy service.
